Beaver Excavating & SCCAA to Offer Paid Training for Surveying Assistants to Stark County, OH Residents

The Stark County Community Action Agency, in conjunction with Beaver Excavating, is offering an eight-week paid training program for individuals looking for a career in construction.

The program takes place July 13 through Aug. 7 and Aug. 10 through Sept. 4. Those who complete it will be certified as a surveying assistant.

Trainees will be paid a \$600 weekly stipend. Program requirements are: must be a Stark County resident age 18 or older, have access to reliable transportation, have a household income at or below 200 percent of federal poverty guidelines and pass drug tests.

Mask Wearing Now Mandatory in Pennsylvania

Pennsylvania Health Secretary Rachel Levine issued an order Wednesday requiring residents to wear masks, with exception, when leaving their homes as COVID-19 cases are on the rise, especially in Allegheny County.

Rules under state Health Sec. Rachel Levine's new mask-wearing order:

- When outdoors and unable to stay six feet away from others who are not members of their household
- When indoors in locations where the public is generally permitted
- While waiting for, riding or driving public transportation
- While obtaining health-care services, either at a hospital, pharmacy, medical clinic, laboratory, physician or dental office, veterinary clinic or blood bank
- When engaged in work, either on-site or off-site

Exceptions:

- Individuals who cannot wear a mask due to a medical condition, including those with respiratory issues, mental health conditions or disabilities
- If mask wearing creates an unsafe condition under state, federal and local guidelines
- Individuals who are unable to remove a mask without assistance
- Those under the age of 2
- Individuals who are communicating with a hearing-impaired individual
- Individuals are not required to show exception documents
